

Supply List for September 2017: MOCI Program

A recommended supply list is below. **Please have your young adult help assemble these items and bring them to school by Monday September 11, 2017.**

I will provide each student with storage containers for his or her emergency clothes and grooming supplies. As a student runs low on these needed items we will send home a supply request sheet so that the items may be replenished or you may choose to have your student buy needed items while on our CBI trips.

Supplies	Due Date
<p><i>Emergency clothing</i> including shirt, pants, underwear, and socks. Spills, illness, and accidents happen your student will be more comfortable when he/she can put on clean clothes.</p>	Monday September 11, 2017 or sooner
<p><i>Gym Clothing:</i> EACH STUDENT will need a change of clothing for gym class. Clothing must conform to the Lake Shore Dress code.</p> <p>Clothing needed: comfortable shorts that come to the knee, a short sleeved T-Shirt (NO TANK TOPS), deodorant, sweatshirt, sweatpants, socks, and gym shoes (unless your student wears them to school on a daily basis).</p> <p>The students will keep their gym clothes at school and they will be responsible for laundering the gym clothes at school on Fridays. Please CLEARLY LABEL ALL CLOTHING with a permanent marker so it can be easily identified after washings.</p>	Monday September 11, 2017 or sooner
<p><i>Hygiene Supplies:</i> Bathroom mirror with suction cups (generally \$8.00 - \$10.00-Target; Bed, Bath, and Beyond, but I have found them at Dollar Tree so look around) Toothbrush, 3 tubes of toothpaste, toothbrush case, 1 bar of soap, and soap case, hand towel, washcloth, comb or brush, Feminine Hygiene products for female students. PLEASE CLEARLY LABEL ALL ITEMS.</p>	Monday September 11, 2017 or sooner
<p><i>Personal Classroom Supplies:</i> 1 Extra Large Pencil Box (large enough to hold the following items): 24 count box of crayons; Glue Sticks (4-6 large); 1 package of colored pencils; 1 pair of scissors that fit your student's hand; 1 package of #2 pencils; easy to use hand-held pencil sharpener; 2 large erasers; 1 VINYL folder (very durable usually less than \$0.50 per folder) 3 composition books (1 with a blue and white cover; 1 with a black and white cover; 1 with a green and white cover- NOT spiral notebooks). I was able to buy most of these items at Target in August 2017 for less than \$20.00 total. Look for sales.</p>	First Day Student starts KMS 9/5/17
<p><i>Classroom Community Supplies:</i> 1 package of napkins; 1 container of Clorox Wipes; 1 bottle of laundry soap; 1 package of paper plates; 2 - 3 boxes of Kleenex.</p>	Monday September 11, 2017 or sooner
<p><i>Wallet</i> carried in the pants pocket on a daily basis or purse. Please consider giving your young adult three dollars to keep in his/her wallet so that he/she may make purchases either at lunch or if we go on an unexpected CBI trip.</p>	First Day Student starts KMS 9/5/17
<p><i>DAILY HEALTHY SNACK</i> for your student.</p>	First Day Student starts KMS 9/5/17
